

## **PARENT PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS FOR 2021**

Somerville Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of Somerville Primary School's parent payment arrangements for 2021

Please find the payment schedule for **Grade 5** attached.

Somerville Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents.

Please complete the **payment** form on page 3 & 4 and return it to the school by **25 October 2020** so the school can place the stationery pack order.

Payments can be made from 2 November 2020. Full payment is due by Monday 18 January 2021.

#### FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES

**Somerville Primary School** understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- **Second–hand uniform shop:** In order to support parents/guardians in meeting the costs of their children's education, parents/guardians can visit the school where good quality second-hand uniforms are available for a gold coin donation.
- CSEF: The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund provides payments for eligible students to attend activities like: school camps or trips; swimming and school-organised sport programs; excursions and incursions. To be eligible to receive the package the student must be a CSEF recipient, generally families who hold a concession card. Please contact the office for more information.
- State Schools Relief (SSR): This is an organisation whose purpose is to support families suffering financial hardship with school requisites such as uniforms, books etc. Prep packages are also offered to those families who have a health care card and receive the CSEF funding. Please contact the school for assistance with SSR.

## **PAYMENT METHODS**

Payments can be made anytime from **Monday 2 November 2020**. We ask that stationary packs are **paid in full by Monday 18**<sup>th</sup> **January 2021**.

#### **BPAY**

Your unique family reference can be found on your family statement or by calling the school.

#### EFTPOS or CREDIT

Payment by *EFTPOS* or *CREDIT* CARD can be made at the school administration office where a receipt will be issued. Payment can also be processed over the phone where a receipt will be sent home.

#### **CASH**

Payment by CASH can be made at the school administration office where a receipt will be issued

#### REFUNDS

- Refunds will only be considered on completion of a parent refund application form and submitted to the Principal.
- Refunds for camp/excursion/incursions/activities will only be processed if the school has not incurred a cost. (For example: if your child has not attended and we were not notified beforehand and the organiser has charged us).
  - o For medical reasons, please provide medical certificates to support your request.
- Refunds will not be processed for voluntary or optional funds paid to the School.

## **STATEMENTS**

Statements will be emailed to parents in Term 4, 2020. The statement will show family Bpay and individual reference details. The statement will show the essential items for 2021.

The primary school may elect to notify parents/guardians of outstanding charges by posting/emailing a Statement of Accounts to the person nominated to receive correspondence for a particular student.

The accounts are normally processed twice a year, but in some instances may be processed more often where directed by School Council and/or the Principal. Reminders for unpaid essential education items or optional extras will be generated and distributed on a regular basis to parents/guardians, but not more than once a term.

All records of payments or contributions and any outstanding payments by parents/guardians and guardians are kept confidential.
